## **MVLE's Path Forward:**

Over the past four months, an MVLE staff work group has met regularly to develop our Path Forward- a phased-in reopening strategy with a focus on how to keep everyone as safe and healthy per guidance from the CDC, VDH and local guidance, while we begin to provide services. We have developed a comprehensive plan and trainings for individuals, and staff. We take this process very seriously and will begin sharing this information over the next several weeks.

This approach to planning has allowed us the opportunity to ensure we are acting on the latest and best information, have personal protection supplies in place, new workplace safety protocols in place, and the opportunity to meet with individuals and their teams to discuss these plans.
